

From the Course

Good day to you and your family; I hope this note finds you well. We are already in summer and it is hard to believe that the year is halfway over. So far we have had mild temperatures and some wellreceived cool nights, and that has been such a blessing. We know the rest of July and August are yet to come, and it is inevitable that we will experience the sweltering heat and humidity that we are so used to in North Carolina. As we move through the summertime, I just wanted to take a minute to let you know a few things you may encounter on the course during the heat. You may come across sprinklers running on the greens or staff hand watering with a hose. Please be patient and know that we will wave you through just as soon as we can. The delay will only be brief, but the benefits of putting the water on the turf cannot be overstated. You also may encounter sprinklers running on other parts of the course as well. We do take care to not run too much on a golf hole so that you may play through without getting wet. Please do your best to avoid these areas directly around the sprinkler and understand that we are working to keep the bermuda grass alive during the heat. We have been fortunate to have timely rains in the past month; however, we know that can change as well.

The greens have healed up from aerifying well, and shortly we will begin our summer venting with a solid tine. This allows oxygen and water to get through the canopy into the root system. This practice is critical for survival of bentgrass and its roots. As always, we will do our best to avoid member events and other situations that will upset our customers.

Throughout the summer I hope you take it slow and easy and enjoy some time off with friends and family at the beach or mountains. Play lots of golf in the mornings and late afternoons and enjoy time at the pool and restaurant as well. As always, we appreciate your patronage and support, and until next time, I'll see you on the course.
